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How to Identify the Boiler Type and Model

1 - Purpose

This document explains how to identify your boiler type and model in the scope of the **2025 voluntary recall** launched by Triangle Tube.

2 - What does your boiler look like?

Click on the image corresponding to your boiler to reach the model identification page

OR


click on the link in the text below the boiler.

If it looks like this, it **IS NOT PART** of the 2025 voluntary recall. No further action is required If it looks like this, it **IS PART** of the 2025 voluntary recall

Go to page 2

If it looks like this, it **MAY BE PART** of the 2025 voluntary recall

Go to page 8



You have a boiler that looks like this

It was produced between 2011 and 2015 and has the following characteristics:

Overall dimensions: 2 sizes of cabinet.

- 1. White front panel
- 2. Grey side panels
- 3. Square gray control panel.
 - ◆ it is a Triangle Tube PT- prefixed boiler if the control panel looks like this (Prestige written at the top and Triangle Tube logo at the bottom)





Your boiler is subjected to the 2025 voluntary recall program.

Go to <u>page 4</u> to identify the model.

◆ it is an Aerco Esteem 399 boiler if the control panel looks like this and there is either this logo either this logo or this logo at the top of the white front panel:





Your boiler is subjected to the 2025 voluntary recall program.

Go to page 3 to know what to do.

3 - What to do if you have an Aerco Esteem Boiler



To identify correctly your appliance and determine the tasks to be performed in the scope of the 2025 Voluntary Recall, the Serial Number of your boiler is necessary.

- 1. If you have it readily available on an invoice or any other documentation related to the boiler, make note of it.
- 2. Connect to Triangle Tube's Customer portal, through which Triangle Tube manages customer requests in the scope of the 2025 Voluntary Recall:

- 3. Alternatively, you can contact your installer or service agency and ask them to proceed with the 2025 voluntary recall on your behalf.
- 4. If you don't have the Serial Number, you can find it behind the front panel, which needs to be removed. See <u>Section 4.2 on page 5</u>.

4 - Identifying a PT- Prefixed Model

4.1 Identification with the Label under the Boiler

Most of the PT models can be identified using the black label located under the appliance.

Please check the boiler model indicated on the label and find your corresponding model in the table at the bottom of the page. Then go to **4.3 on page 7**

You can make note of the collected information in the form provided on **page 10**.

NOTICE

The labels affixed under the boiler are black and look like this:





For ease of reading this document however, they are represented white with black prints.





NOTICE

The PT 175 and PT 250 models cannot be differentiated with this label. Therefore, to know which model you have, the front panel of the cabinet needs to be opened to see the rating

label. See **Section 4.2 on page 5**.



4.2 Removing the Front Panel (Models 175 and 250 only and Esteem 399 boilers)

A WARNING

This procedure requires the removal of a thumbscrew located at the top of the unit. Depending on the height at which the boiler is installed on the wall, a stable ladder or platform may be required for safe access.

This procedure requires lifting and handling the front panel. The front panel weighs about 9Lbs [4 kg] and is cumbersome (about 37" [95 cm] high and 24" [60 cm] wide). Before taking any action, make sure that you can handle such an item. In doubt, please call for help (a family member, a friend, a neighbor, or your boiler service company.)

A WARNING

ELECTRIC SHOCK HAZARD!

Ensure power to the boiler has been switched off prior to opening the front panel of the unit.

1. Depress the main switch located at the front of the boiler to switch off. See illustration below.




2. Allow the unit to cool down for at least 15 minutes.

4. Holding the panel by its sides, slightly lift the panel and pull away from the unit.



4.2.1 Collecting the Data from the Rating Label

The rating label is located next to the control panel, inside the boiler.

What to check:

- 1. On the rating label, check if your model is a Prestige Solo 175 or 250 (2).
- 2. Collect information of Serial Number (1) and gas type (3).
- You can make note of the collected information in the form provided on <u>page 10</u>.



Make a picture of the rating label.




Fig. 1 - Location of Rating Label and Details on PT Boilers



5. Restart the boiler by pushing the main switch on the control panel



4.3 Follow-on tasks (All PT models)


- 1. As a rule, try to find (if missing at this stage):
 - ◆ the boiler Serial Number (e.g. from an invoice or other document from your contractor)
 - the gas type used to operate the boiler (e.g. invoice from the gas company).

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- If you managed to get the Serial Number of your appliance, you can contact Triangle Tube as indicated on <u>page 10</u>. in order to fill in the relevant information and proceed with the 2025 voluntary recall.
- 3. Alternatively, you can contact your installer or service agency and ask them to proceed with the 2025 voluntary recall on your behalf.



You have a Triangle Tube **PA-/PEA- or PB-/PEB- prefixed Boiler** if it looks like this and has the following characteristics:

Overall dimensions: 3 sizes of cabinet.

- 1. White casing
- 2. ACV () or Triangle Tube () logo at the front
- 3. "Prestige" name embossed on the front panel.
- 4. Rectangular control panel with stainless steel look.

If you have a boiler of this type, identify the model to determine if it is subjected to the 2025 voluntary recall program.

Go to page 9 to identify the model.

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5 - Identifying a PA-/PEA- prefixed Model

5.1 Rating Label

The rating label (and/or conversion rating label) is located on the right side panel of the boiler.

NOTICE

If the rating label is not readable because of insufficient clearance, try to make a picture with your phone.

What to check:

1. Check the Serial Number (3). If it starts with PB or PEB then your boiler IS NOT part of the 2025 voluntary recall.

- 2. Is there a PB label affixed on the Serial Number (3)? then your boiler IS NOT part of the 2025 recall, it was already part of the 2020 recall*.
- 3. From the rating label, collect information of model (1), Serial Number (2) and gas type (3 or 4).
- 4. You can note the collected information in the form provided on **page 10**.




Fig. 2 - Location of Rating Label and Details on PA Boilers
